- Develop and recommend environmental policies and guidelines for the college, including green procurement and sustainable building practices.
- Ensure compliance with local and national environmental regulations and standards.
- Monitor the campus's environmental performance and track progress toward sustainability goals.
- Prepare and submit regular reports on environmental activities, achievements and areas for improvement to the college administration.
- Encourage active participation from students in environmental projects, leadership roles and decision-making processes.
- Prepare an annual report detailing the Eco Green Campus Cell's activities, achievements, and challenges.
- Submit the report to the college administration for review and approval, and use it to plan future initiatives.
- Maintain accurate records of all environmental initiatives, projects, and expenditures.
- Ensure that records are securely stored and accessible for review and reporting purposes.
