PREFACE

The aim of excavation is to examine the archaeological resource within a given area or site within a framework defined research objects, to seek a better understanding of and compile a lasting record of that resource, to analyse and interpret the results and disseminate them.

Anthropology is the study of human beings especially of their origin, development, customs and beliefs. Anthropogeographic is the study of geographic distribution of human. The study of Geology has also provided Archaeology with information to unlock the past knowledge of rocks and



minerals can be used to identify where materials for stone tools, pottery and buildings. Also Radio-carbon dating is a method for determining the age of an object containing organic material by using the properties of radio-carbon, a radioactive isotope of carbon. Recently New Archaeology stressed theory formation, model building and hypothesis testing in the search for general laws of human behavior cultural history. It is fruitless to tell a story about a cultural change unless we are going to test its inferences. It is clear that the Indian Archaeology still remains in what may be described as a descriptive stage. An analytical stage in Archaeology cannot emerge without a sound theoretical foundation for the structure of culture or change. Such a change seems a very remote likelihood without developing Anthropological archaeology in India.

From the Archaeological excavation it is evident that the Paleolithic people used basic stone and bone tools and crude stone axes for hunting birds and wild animals. Hence, the goal of archaeology is to understand how and why human behavior has changed overtime. This second international conference of LRF entitled, the Revelation of Archaeological excavation will give the solution for the hidden questions of the scholars towards the Archaeological Revelations.

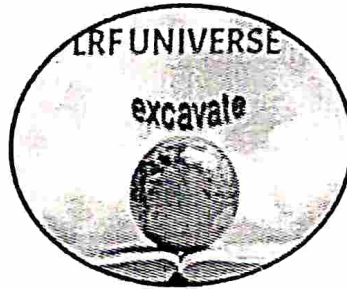

Most of the visitors to Kanyakumari only know of the confluence of the three Oceans, the temple of Devi Kanyakumari, the Shrines of Adi Sankara, Swami Vivekananda, Mahatma Gandhi and Kamaraj on the golden sand, besides, of course, the land mark of Vivekananda Rock Memorial. How many would know that beneath the Indian Ocean, there were the remnants of a vibrant and hoary civilization of the Hindus going back to Centuries, which were submerged by periodical cataclysmic landslips during the remote past? The Lemurian theory of continental drift which hold the view that there was a large mass of land to the south of Kanyakumari carries the History of South India in general and TamilNadu in particular to very ancient times. In the old map the present Himalayan range was shown as Sea. Only a geologist can state conclusively that the location of the present Himalayan ranges was the site of a shallow sea only almost some 20 million years ago. The discovery of the thrilling facts that the

The study of the fossils alone, in the rocks of the different sectors of the globe could establish the antiquity of the land's end promontory of India. The huge landmass in the old world map was known as **Naavalam Theevu**, which means the land surrendered by sea on all the four sides.

Seismic disturbances, cataclysmic landslips, Volcanic upheals and tidal waves had submerged a vast expanse of landmass to the South of Kanyakumari. The forefathers of the renowned civilization lived and thrived there. Western Scholars and Historians refer to the great landmass to the South of Kanyakumari as **Lemuria** which broke up several Thousand years ago. According to Tamil tradition, the lost **Lemuria** is known as "**Kumari Nadu**".

Other commentators on **Irayanar Ahapporul** and **Silapathikaram** give a detailed description of **Kumari Nadu** and the **Old Tamil Sangams**.

These literary factors cannot be brushed aside as mere imagination and exaggeration. The archaeological excavations held at **Alagankulam** near **Ramanathapuram** and the under water archaeological explorations held at **Poompuhar** confirm the detailed description of the places mentioned in ancient Tamil literature. So much so, if any excavation in the land and exploration in the sea are undertaken around **Kanyakumari** the truth about the lost **Lumuria** or **Kumari Nadu** will come to the lime light of History.

In this context, Muslim Arts College, Thiruvithancode has initiated a new beginning of excavating the hidden History of the Lands End by inaugurating the **Lemuria Research Forum**. I am
